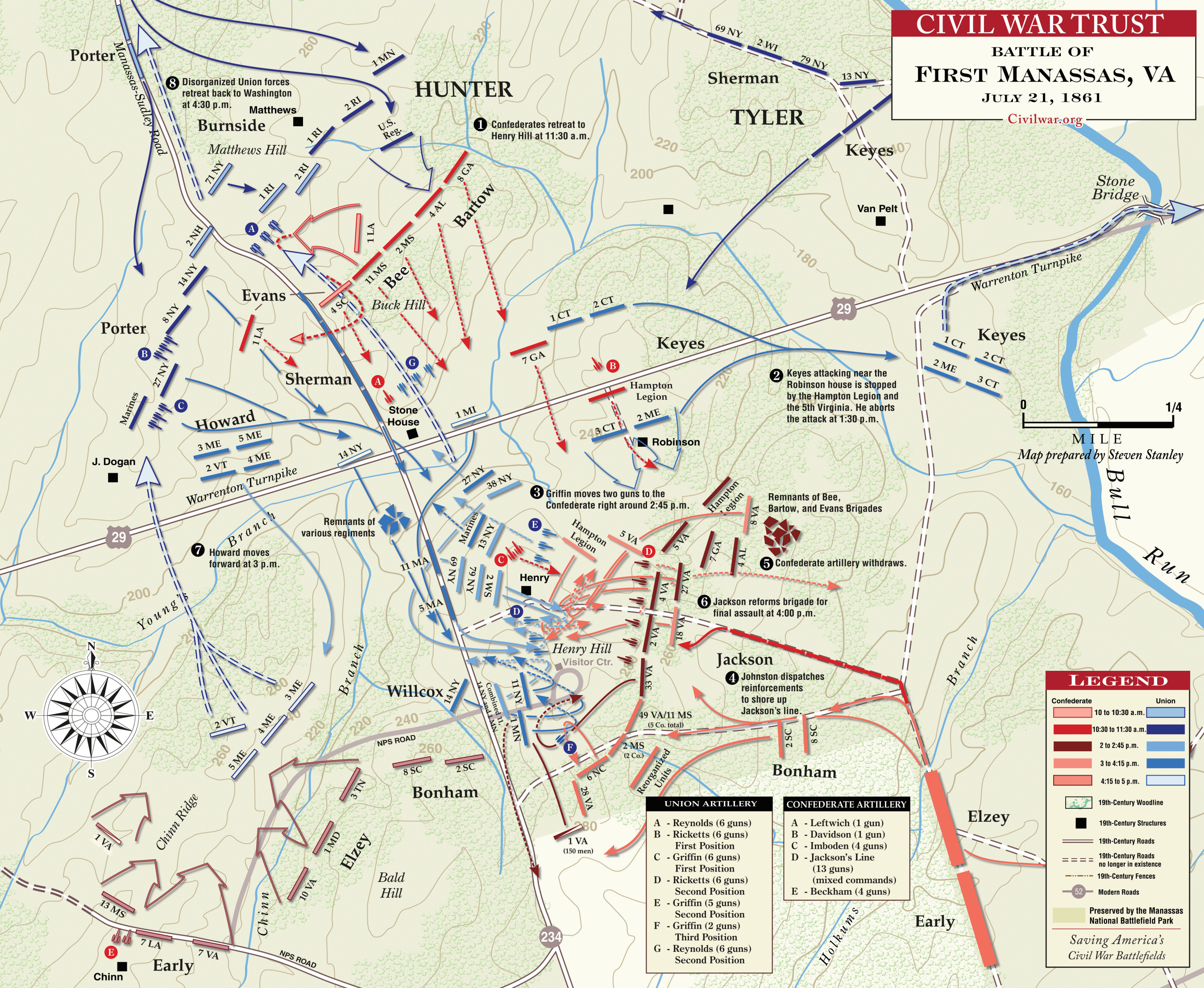


CIVIL WAR TRUST

8 Disorganized Union forces retreat back to Washington at 4:30 p.m.

1 Confederates retreat to Henry Hill at 11:30 a.m.

2 Keyes attacking near the Robinson house is stopped by the Hampton Legion and the 5th Virginia. He aborts the attack at 1:30 p.m.

3 Griffin moves two guns to the Confederate right around 2:45 p.m.

5 Confederate artillery withdraws.

6 Jackson reforms brigade for final assault at 4:00 p.m.

4 Johnston dispatches reinforcements to shore up Jackson's line.

7 Howard moves forward at 3 p.m.
